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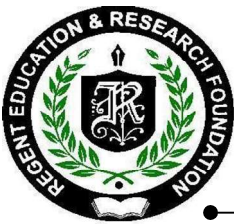

Summary of the session's key takeaways and a vote of thanks, emphasizing the continued importance of

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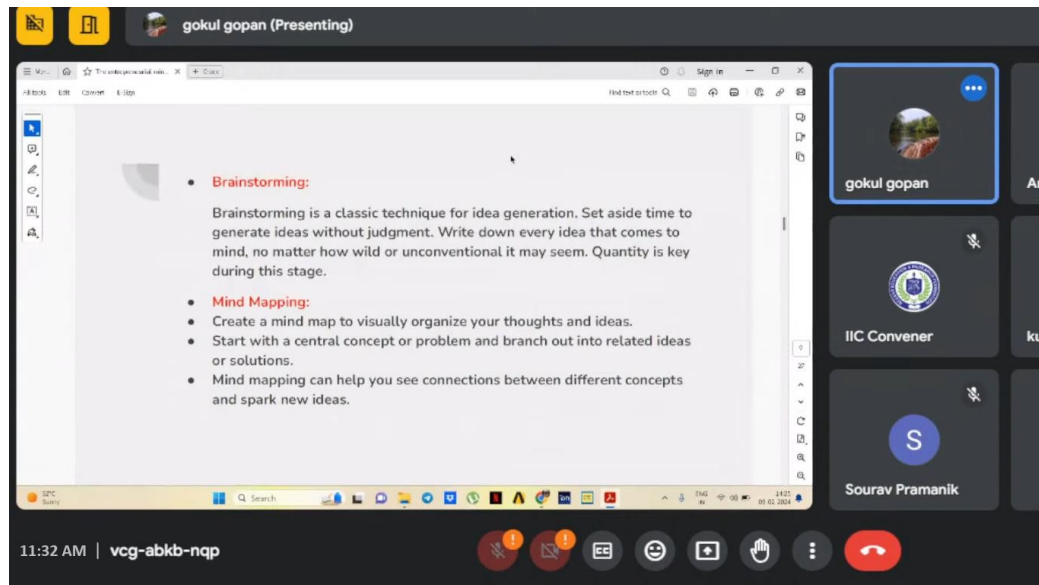


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developing entrepreneurship skills, attitudes, and behaviors for future success.

The virtual session "Entrepreneurship Skill, Attitude, and Behaviour Development," hosted on the 9th of

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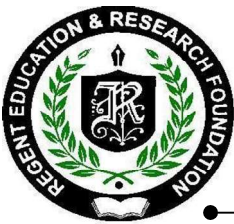

- 6. Networking and Community Building:** The session facilitated networking among like-minded individuals passionate about entrepreneurship. This community-building aspect of the program fosters

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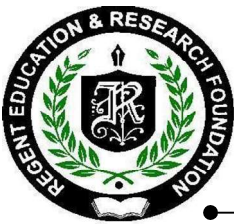
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ongoing support and collaboration among aspiring entrepreneurs within the institution.
